Dallas bus schedules

Dr. Gilbert Griffiths, Superintendent of the Dallas School District, announces the following bus schedules for the first day of school, Wednesday, August 27.

Most routes and times will remain the same as last school year. The secondary starting time for the bus runs is approximately 7:00 a.m. and the elementary starting time is approximately 8:20 a.m.

These bus lists will be in effect for the first week of school. Changes will be made where necessary in both times and locations as the school year progresses. Please note that all times are approximate.

The Kindergarten students are reminded of their participation in the school entry program. Their schedule will be given to them by their teachers at the screening conference prior to the opening of school.

The Seminary Lower School run will remain the same. Any student not along the current Seminary bus route is to call the Dallas School District transportation office at extension #229. These students will board the Dallas Middle School/Seminary High bus that picks up in their area and transfer to a shuttle bus at the Middle School for transportation to Wyoming Seminary Lower School. PM transportation will be on a shuttle bus that will take the student to a Dallas Elementary school for transfer to their appropriate PM bus.

The district announces that no unauthorized entry on a school bus will be allowed. Under Pennsylvania Title 18, Crimes and Offenses, legislation has been introduced into Congress which states "...any person who enters a school bus without prior authorization of the driver...commits a misdemeanor of the third degree."
