### L.C.C.C. offers three new programs

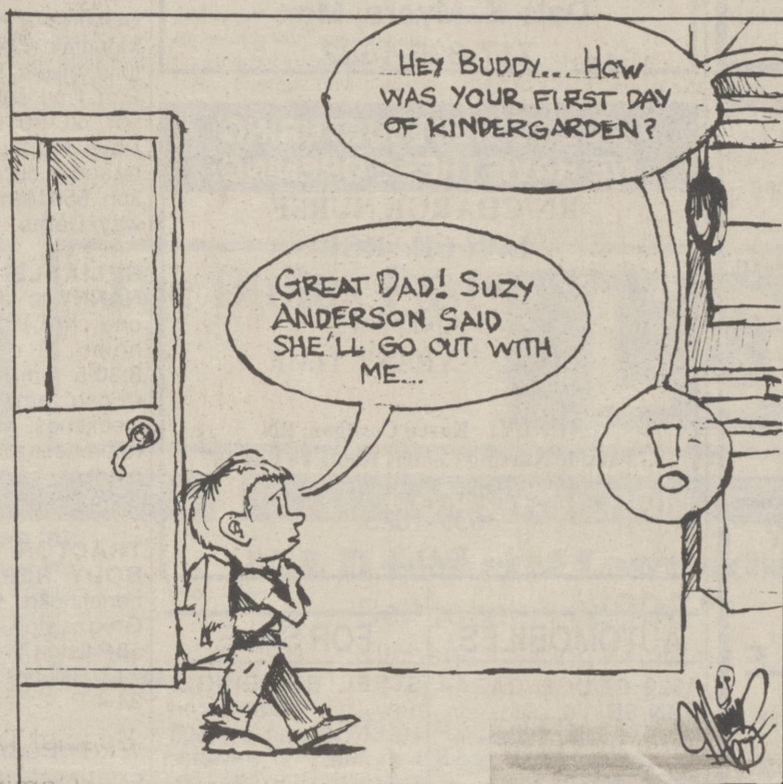
Luzerne County Community College will offer three new diploma programs this Fall in the Information Systems Technology area.

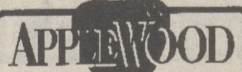
