Zarno, Yeager win Lehman Golf Club titles

Jack Zarno won the 1997 Club Championship at Lehman Golf Club on Sunday with a 3-under par total of 133. Jack scored a 65 on Saturday and a 68 on Sunday to win by 3 shots over many-time Club Champion Bob Zagorsky, Jr. Zagorsky's two-round total was even par 136. Third place went to first round leader Gary Williams, who scored 64-73, for a 137 total. Dave Guss scored 69-70 (139) to

finish fourth. This marks the fourth time for Zarno to win the Club Championship, with previous titles coming in 1977, 1983, and 1996.

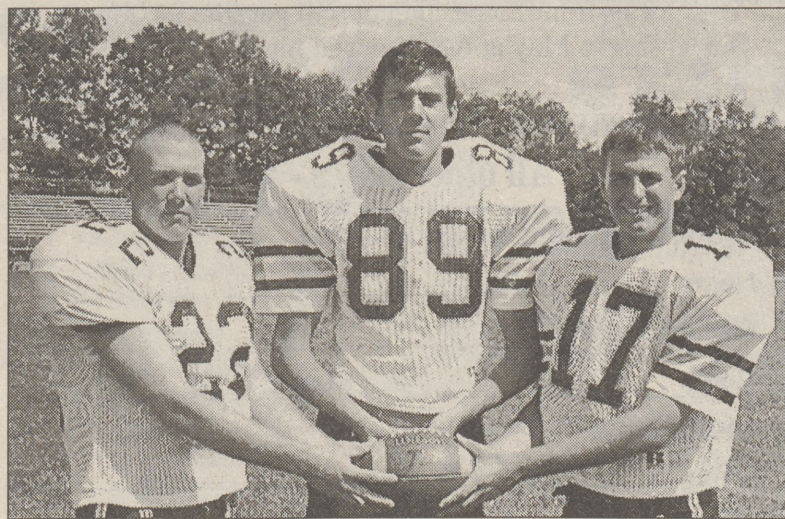
Local women sweep regional golf tournament
