Horlacher Little League signups Saturday

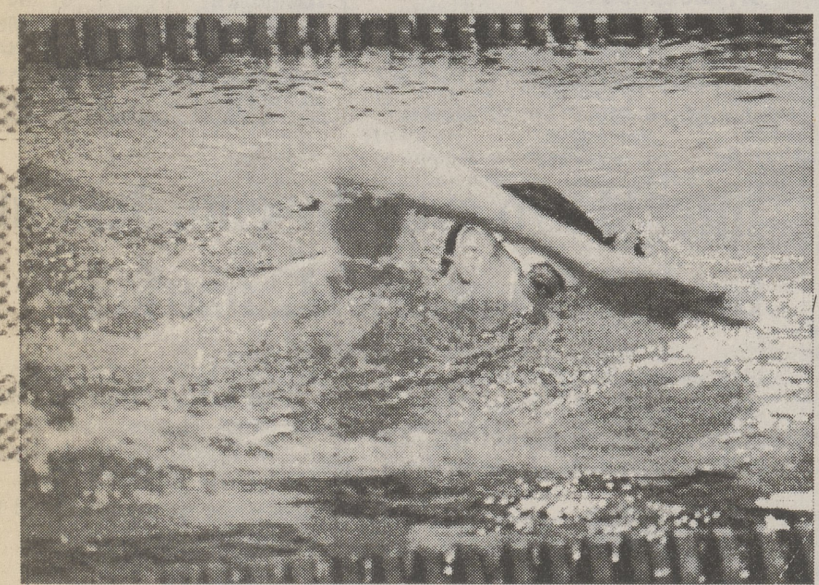
