Said taxes are necessary for general revenue purposes to pay the salaries of the employees as prescribed in the salary schedules of the district and to meet the current expenses of the Dallas School District. The proposed budget may be inspected by an interested person or persons at the office of the Secretary of the Board, Administration Office, Church Street, Dallas, PA. It is the intent of the Board to adopt the budget at the Special Board Meeting to be held June 22, 1998.
