



You're helping the library with every bite

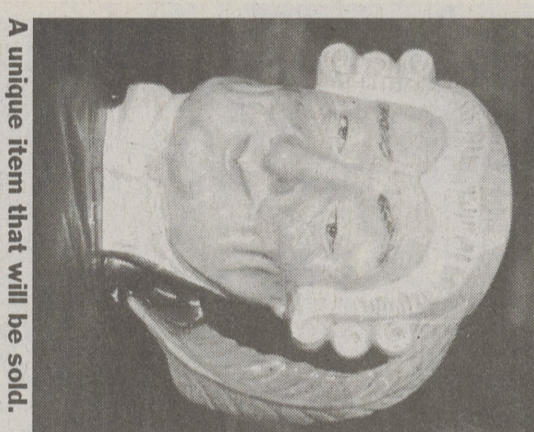

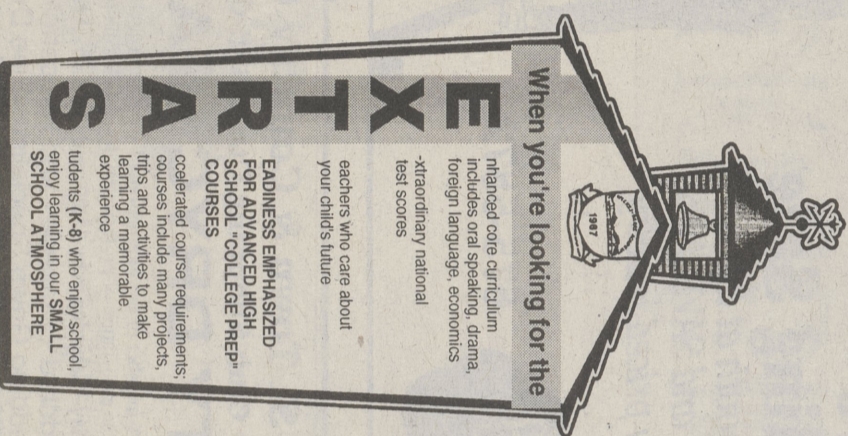
