The Back Mountain Memorial Library circulated 10,019 books during the month of July; adult fiction, 3,268; juvenile fiction 3,977; adult non-fiction 1,308; juvenile non-fiction 1,466. Reference questions answered 333; Book Club books circulated 268; Interlibrary loan transactions 31; CDs 63; audio tapes 544; and videos 435. New books added to the collection: adult 146, juvenile 63, books withdrawn: adult 26, juvenile 60. New borrowers: adults 74, juvenile 76. Adult re-registrations 51, juvenile 69. Total active borrowers July 31 = 11,491.
