Dalley, a senior who will move from center to guard, senior Floyd McKay at fullback and junior Travis McKay at fullback.

Carl Sgarlat, a two-year starter on the offensive and defensive line, will likely miss the season after suffering a broken ankle in the team's first scrimmage.

"Carl's injury is a major loss," said Gorgone. "He gave us experience on both sides of the ball."

Joining Kapsion in the backfield will be junior Rich Patton and sophomore Iv Nulton at tailback. Travis McKay and junior John Piteavage will split time at fullback.

Morris will handle the split end duties while Floyd McKay and junior D.J. Harris will be at wingback.

"We will have to mix things up offensively to be successful," explained Gorgone. "To do that, we need to establish our running game. We have some big backs. They don't have blazing speed, but they can wear people down."

The running game will depend on the offensive line of junior center Dave DeLong, Dalley and senior Brent Stransky at guard, junior Matt Kehler and senior Palmer Edwards at tackle and junior Gregg Woronko at tight end.

## Lehman at the top of a strong conference

If Lake-Lehman field hockey coach Jean Lipski is correct when she says success breeds success, the rest of the Wyoming Valley Conference had better be ready.

The knights were 15-3-1 and won their third consecutive District 2 "AA" championship a year ago. This season, seven starters return and hope to continue the tradition.

"Our program is almost a circle," explained Lipski, who is assisted by Sandy Boyle and volunteer coach Lynn Coury. "The upperclassmen know what it takes to win and work very hard. The new kids see how the veterans work and do the same."

Lehman returns four starters at forward including senior Leigh Ann Isaac, juniors Janelle Perlis and Melissa DeCesaris and sophomore Alyson Bevan.

Isaac, a two-year starter, is a team tri-captain along with Jill Marchakitus and Jen Johnstone. Marchakitus, a three-year starter, returns on defense.

Johnstone, a four-year starter, is back at midfield. Junior Rachel Kasper also returns in the midfield.

"I'm very pleased with our progress so far and with our enthusiasm," said Lipski. "We've got some very good returning players as well as some good young players who are battling for spots. We are pretty deep and we have enough versatility to give us some options."

Lipski hopes to take advantage of the team's quickness and experience on the forward line, especially in the early going as the young defense comes together.

"We're quick and very skilled," said Lipski. "We're solid up front. The players know each other and work well together. We are rebuilding on defense where we will have several young players."

The team's other strength is its physical conditioning. "We work very hard on conditioning,"

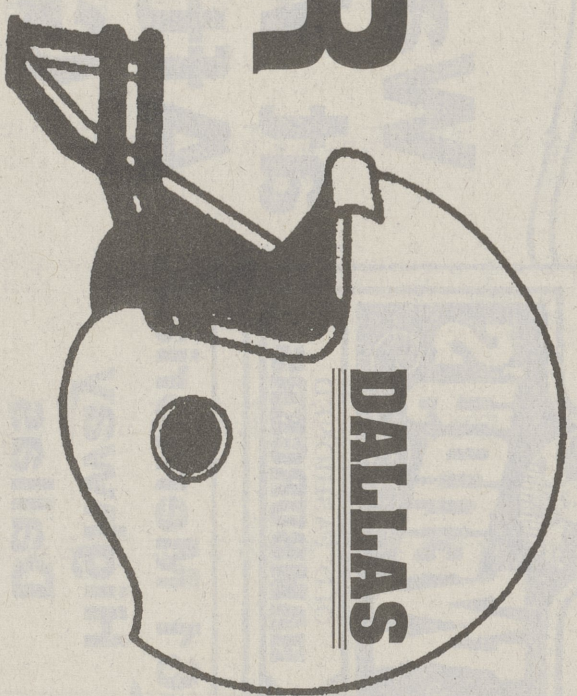
