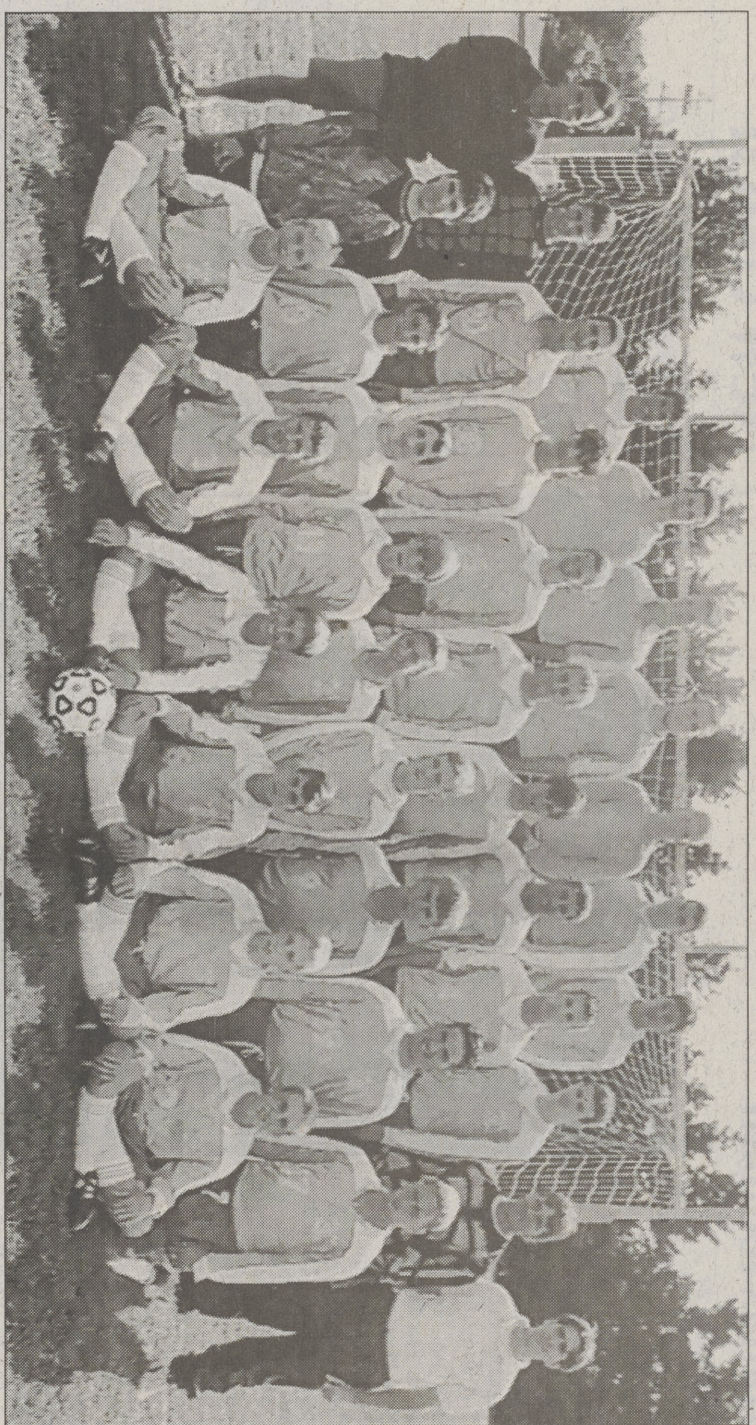
Justin Hoover and Rich Semanas both return at forward. "Both of these guys have good speed and can score," said Scharff.

Junior Russ Mosier, the goalkeeper for the United States Region 1 U-17 team, returns in goal. Mosier is a team captain and will be backed up by classmate Giles Moore.

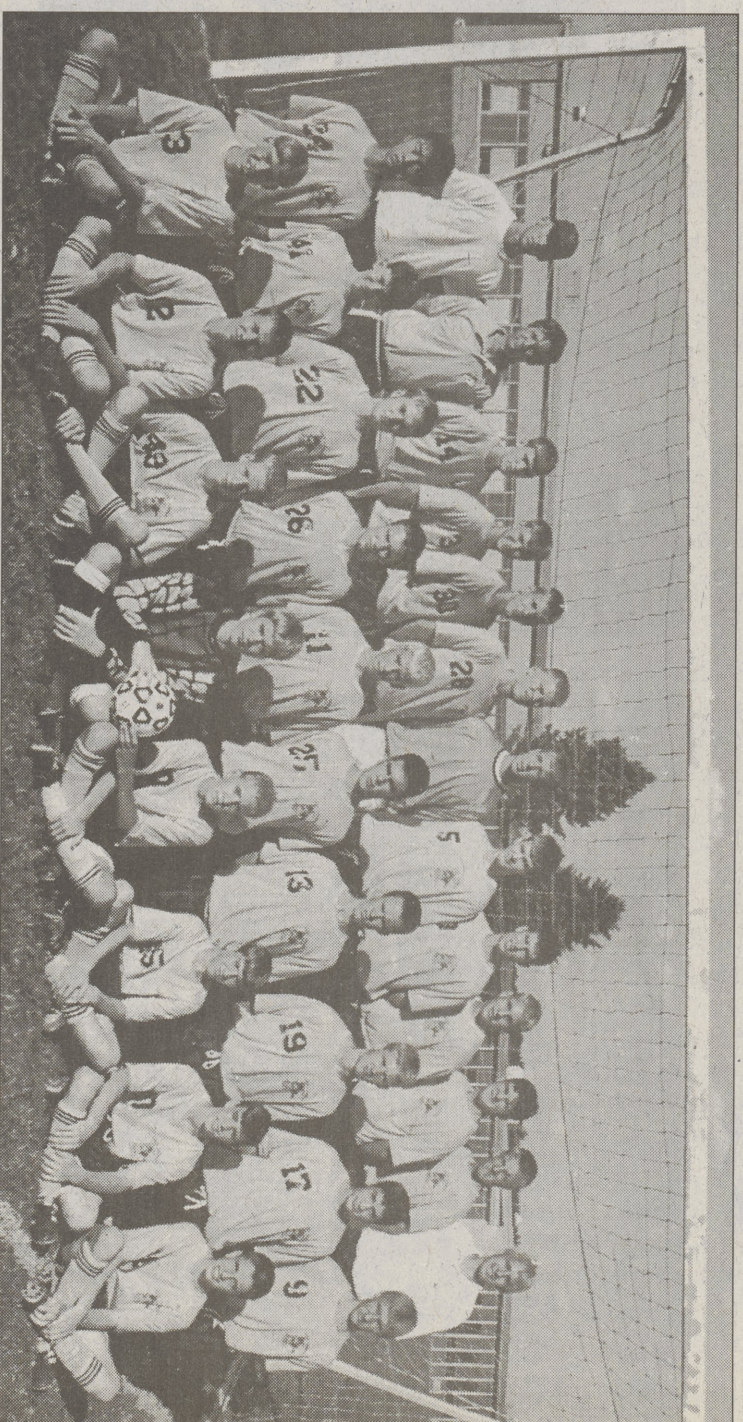
