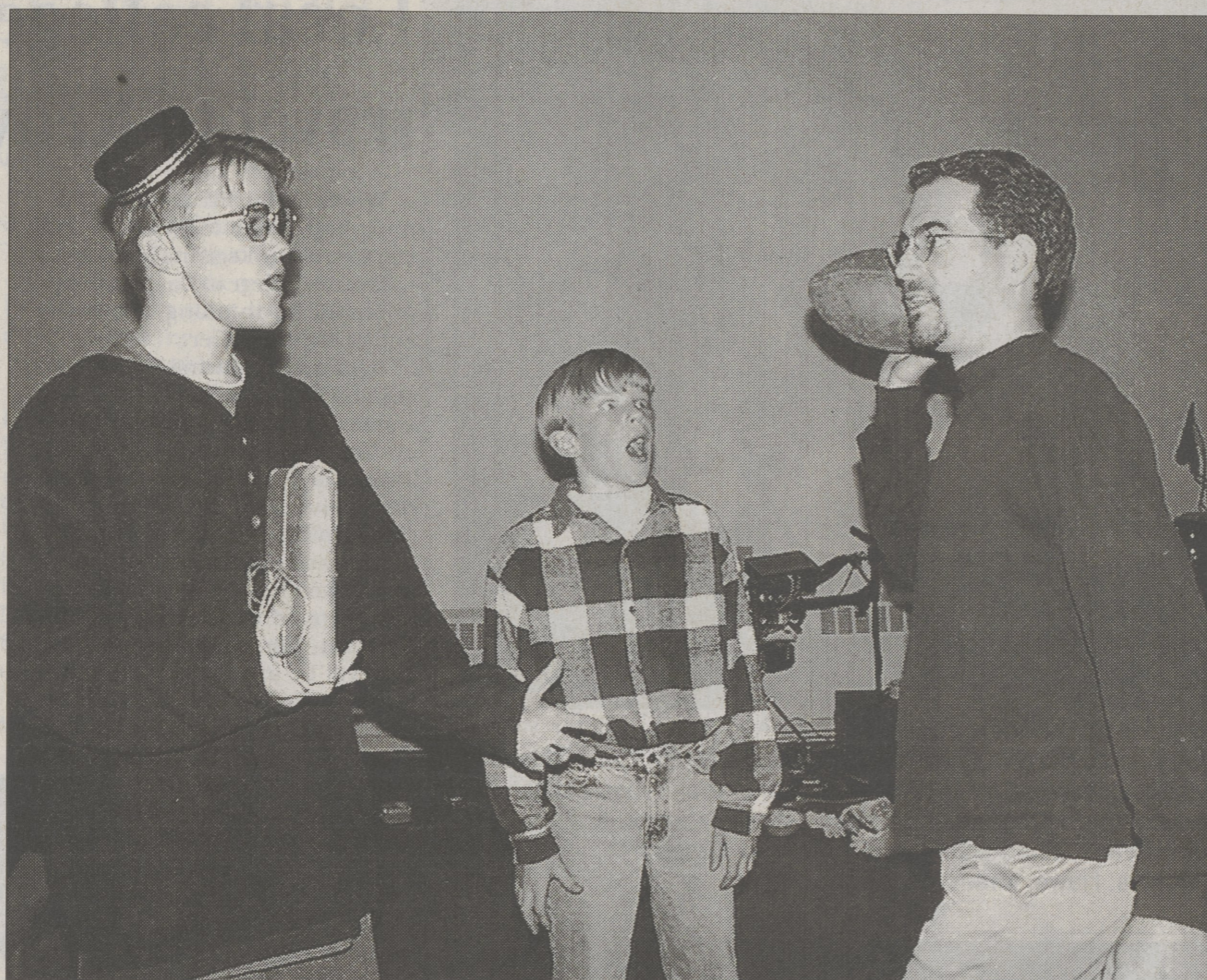


A funny holiday

Need a gift? Library has something different

The Back Mountain Memorial Library has numerous items for sale that would make nice Christmas gifts for someone special on your list. The children's cookbook, "Junior Chefs and Artists" sells for \$9.50 and includes recipes the young people have cooked, written and shared their talents to make the book, in honor of the new children's wing. The book includes appetizers, beverages, soup, salads, breads, rolls, vegetables, main dishes and desserts.
