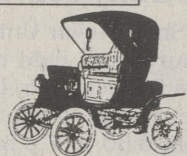

CTCO HOOKS KIDS TO SANTA IN TIME FOR HOLIDAY

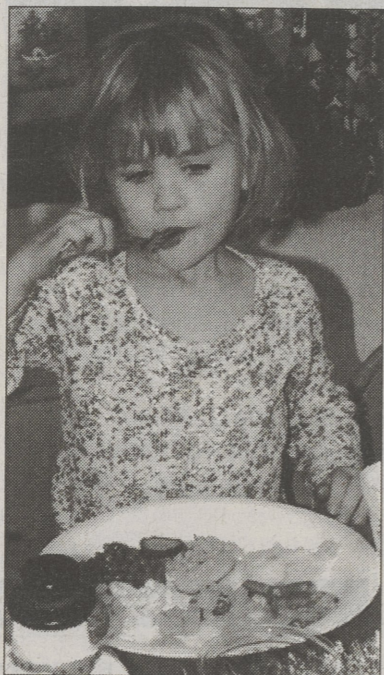
