Weaver is semi-finalist for Coca-Cola scholarship

Kenneth Michael Weaver, of Lake-Lehman High School has been selected from over 137,000 applicants nationwide as semi-finalists in the 1998-99 Coca-Cola Scholars Program. He ranks among nearly 2,000 seniors who are in the running for \$1.4 million in college scholarships being awarded by the Coca-Cola Scholars Foundation. Students are selected to advance to this phase based on the level of excellence, leadership and

achievement demonstrated in school and community activities. This year is the 11th year Coca-Cola will be awarding scholarships, providing a total of \$15.2 million to assistance students nationwide. As semifinalists, students must submit additional information which will be reviewed in February by a committee comprised of 21 educators from high schools and universities throughout the United States. Weaver will be among of 151 Finalists who will travel to Atlanta April 22-25, 1999 to attend the Coca-Cola Scholars Weekend. During their visit they will attend a final interview process which will determine whether they are designated as either a National or Regional Scholar. The 51 National Scholars will each receive a four-year \$20,000 renewable scholarship award. Regional Scholars will receive a four-year \$4,000 renewable scholarship.
