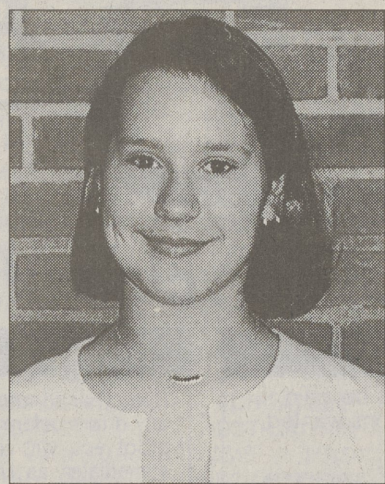

The Lake-Lehman team of Ken Weaver, Angela Davis, Corey Makarewicz and Sean Manzoni finished in fifth place at the 11th annual Newton Math Competition held recently at the Penn State Wilkes-Barre campus in Lehman. More than 100 students from 12 area high schools participated in the all-day event. In the morning session, students competed on an individual basis. The afternoon had teams of four students working collectively to solve six problems. Awards went to the

top three teams and the top five individuals.

Kenneth Weaver finished in eighth place as an individual.

The Newton Math Competition was founded in 1988 by Dr. M. Nouri, professor of mathematics at the campus, to create incentive in the subject matter for students. It was named after Sir Isaac Newton, who was a mathematician and physicist and the inventor of calculus. John Graham, Penn State mathematics instructor, coordinates the competition.
