PSU offering computer workshops

The fall series of computer workshops at Penn State Wilkes-Barre will begin Sept. 17. The series is designed for various levels of computer literacy, and offers training workshops for everyone interested in improving their computer skills for more effective and efficient use of their computers. For novice computer users, the Introduction to PC Computing gives a conceptual understanding of the various computer components and a working knowledge of computer terminology. The use of computers as tools to manage information and data are explored. Workshops are scheduled to provide introductory to advanced skill training in various software applications such as Word for word processing, Excel for spreadsheets, Access for database management, and Powerpoint for pre-

sentations. New this fall are courses on the Windows '98 operating system, Microsoft Outlook for e-mail and schedule management, and two levels of skill training in the Microsoft Project. Level four Excel and Access classes focus on the use of Visual Basic Applications. A full course on all Microsoft software applications is offered at Penn State Wilkes-Barre's off-campus location on Rt. 315 in Wilkes-Barre on Wednesday evenings from 6-9 p.m. throughout the fall. All other workshops are offered at the campus in Lehman in a new, state-of-the-art computer lab. The schedule includes both day and weekend workshops.
