He was a U.S. Army Air Corps veteran of World War II.

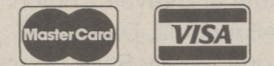
He was preceded in death by his wife, Arline Devine Hughes.

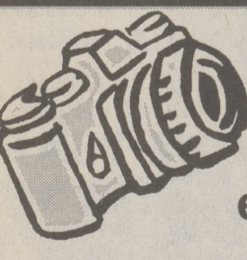
