New Miseri education scholarship

In an effort to support efforts to bring 100,000 new teachers into the nation's elementary schools, College Misericordia offers a new scholarship for education students.

The scholarship, called "School Partnership Scholarships", provides a total of \$10,000 in financial aid to full-time college students interested in teaching in elementary schools. Students who receive the Misericordia scholarship receive \$2,500 per year for four years while they are enrolled

in the college's teacher education program.

The college asks school district officials to identify high school students who would be good candidates for careers in teaching. These students are required to have a high school grade point average of B or better to show their interest in working with children through community involvement and to indicate a desire to become teachers.
