

## Kingston Twp. supervisors pass resolution supporting DAMA

The Kingston Township Board of Supervisors has unanimously passed Resolution 1997-7. The Board of Supervisors has passed the resolution in support of efforts by the Dallas Area Municipal Authority to collect past due fees owned by the General Municipal Authority of Harveys Lake Borough. The amount owed to Dallas Area Municipal Authority is over \$400,000 dating back to 1993. Kingston Township feels that it

is completely unfair to the rate payers of Kingston Township to subsidize sewage disposal in Harveys Lake Borough. The Resolution supports Dallas Area Municipal Authority utilizing any legal means available to collect the fees owed by Harveys Lake Borough.

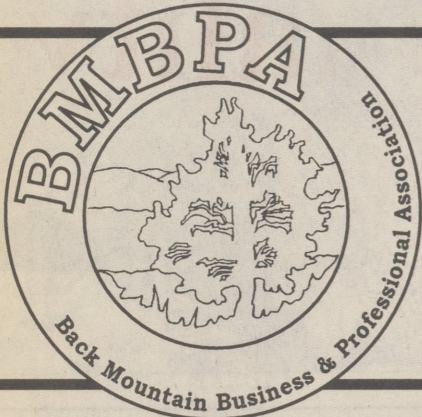
