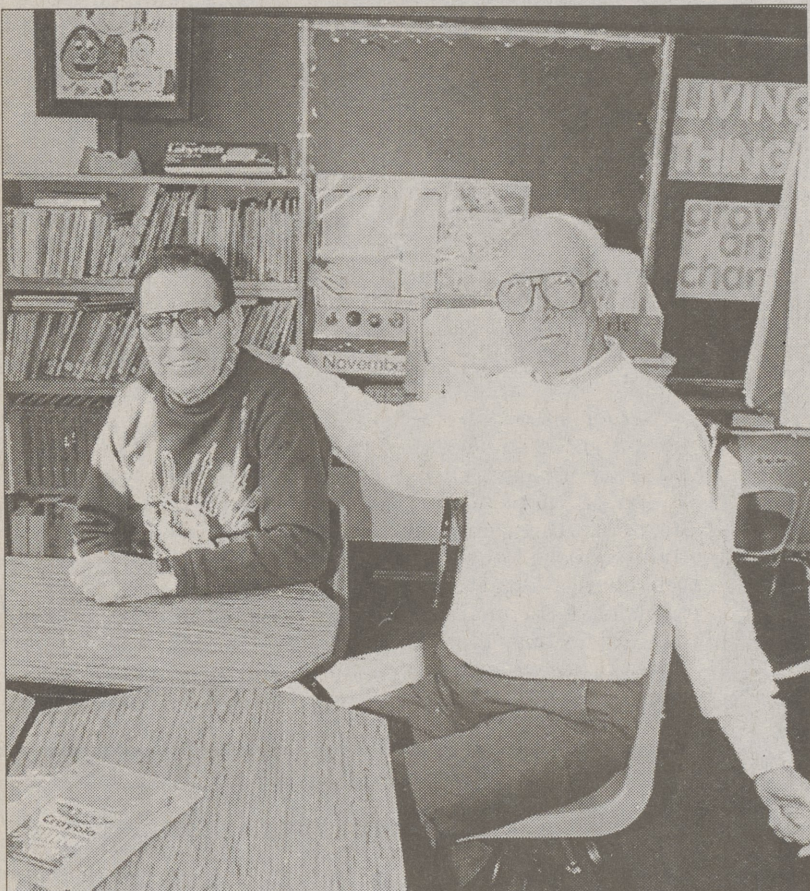


Feb. 3 - The house in which 30-year-old Delinda Adkins had died was being renovated just days after her death, which is still being investigated.

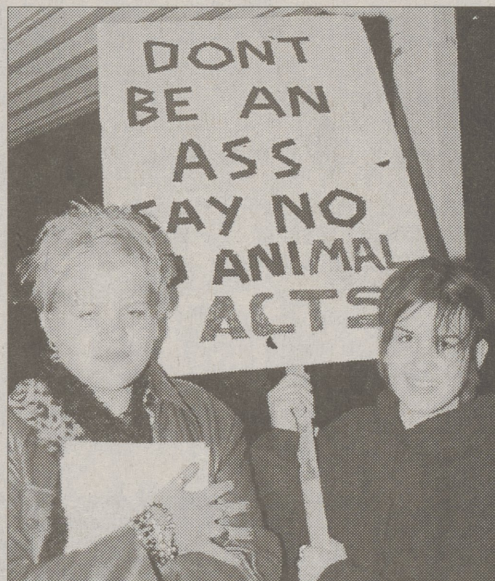

March 17 - Emily Mallick, left, led a protest against the annual donkey basketball game at Dallas High School. She was joined by Cindy Taren outside the gym.



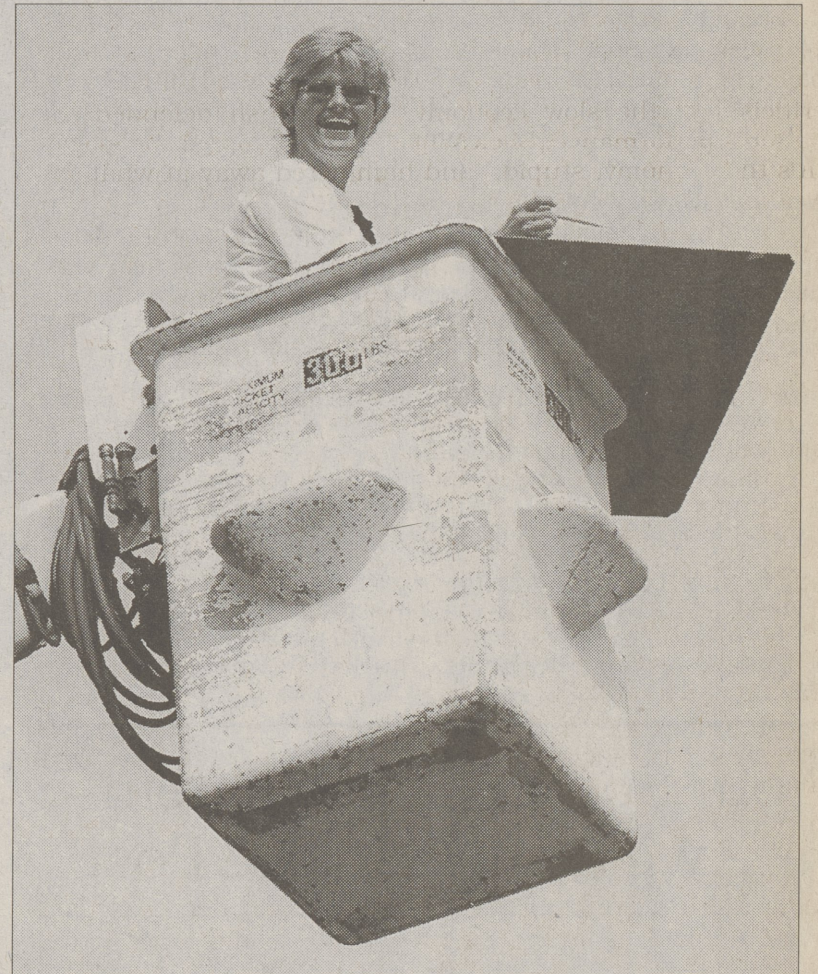
April 28 - Adam Besecker sported a pair of custom shades he built for the "Science Expo" at Dallas Elementary School.



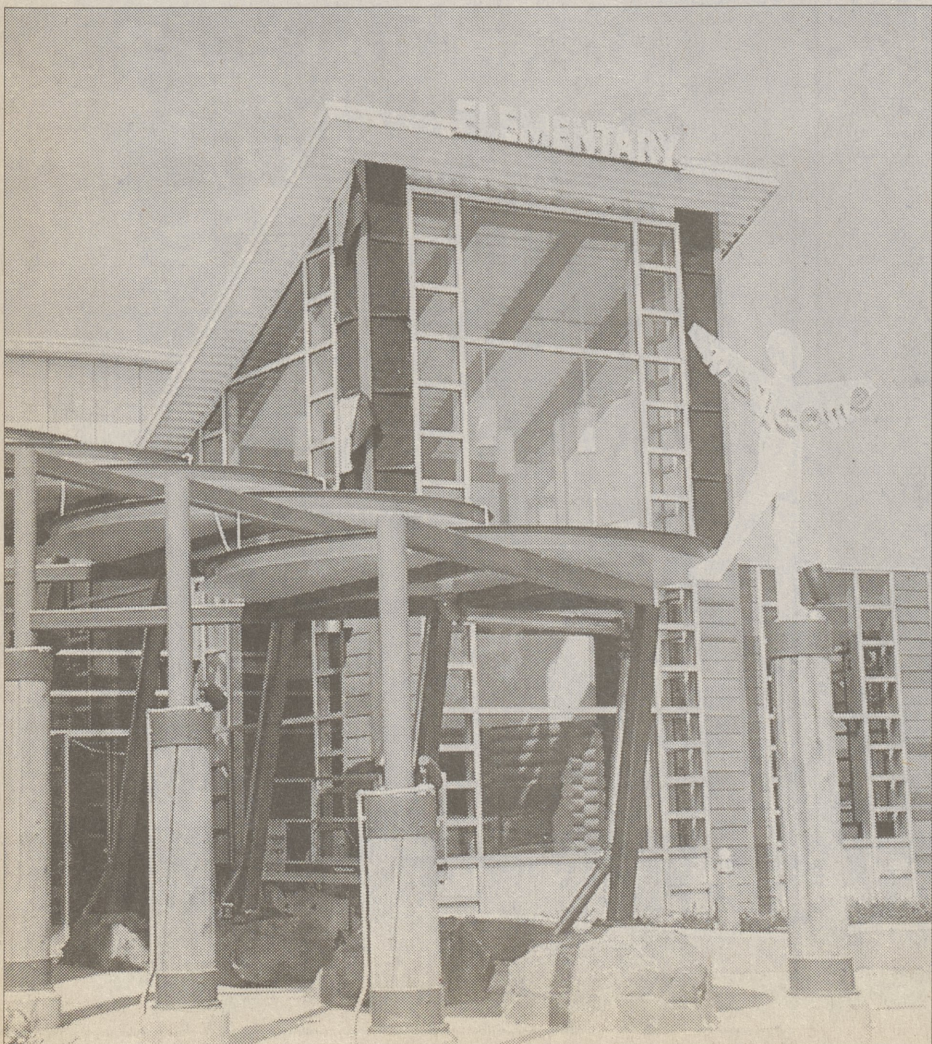
