a pond on Hildebrandt Road that shows a retaining wall," said Hand.

"Through the structures I've tried to show the culture of our area. We have some of the best structures and best people and culture in the nation. I get so impatient with people who put down our area. I just wanted to show my pride in Northeastern Pennsylvania."

A book, "Insights: Notes and Sketches from the Millennium Collection," which chronicles the collection, is available for purchase. "The paintings show the outside but I wanted to share the inside view — my own internal thoughts," said Hand. The introduction to the book also explains the artist's thoughts about our area. Each of the descriptions includes a line drawing of the composition.

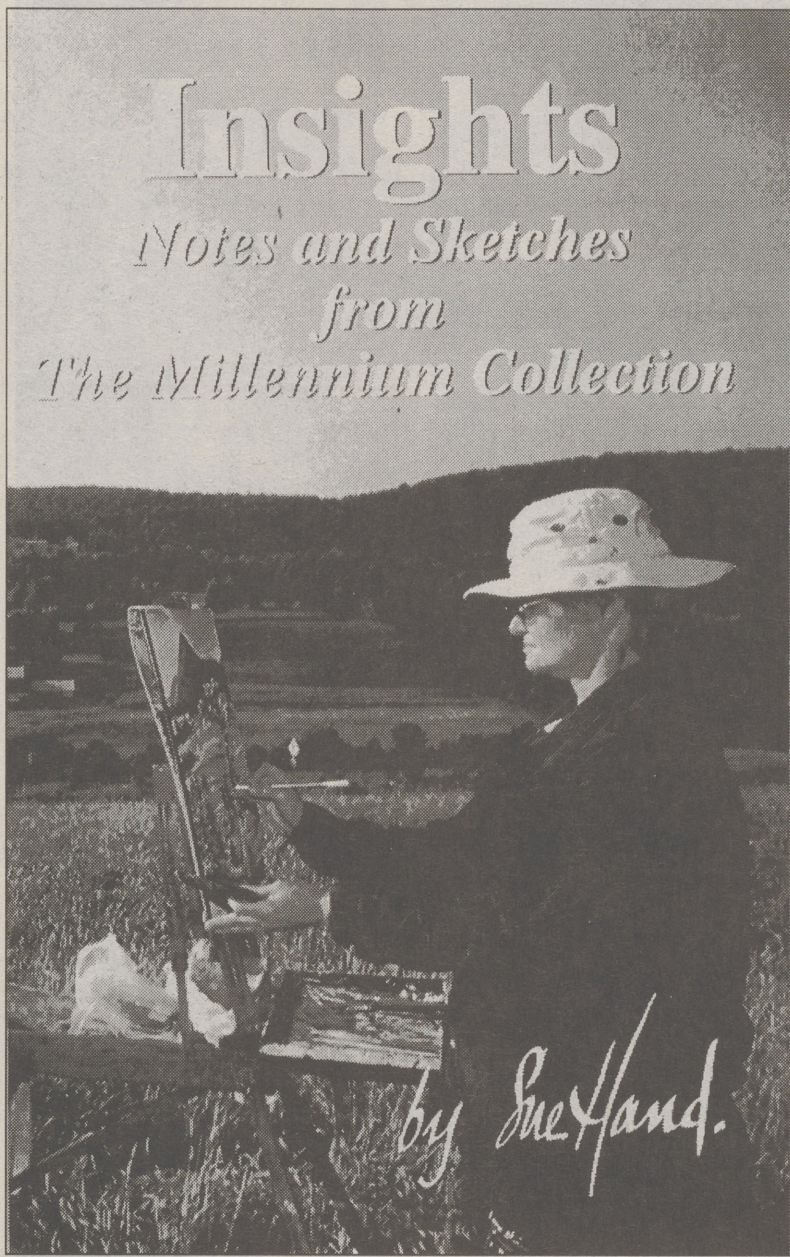
Hand started to work on this project three years ago in the spring of 1997. "Some of the pieces were sold since that time but I was able to borrow them back for this show," she said. All but two of the others are available for purchase.

"The two that I am keeping are personal. One is of my own Dallas studio on Main Street and the other is of my mother-in-law's house next door. Six generations of my husband's family have lived in that house over the years," Hand said. Sue and Joe Hand have been married for 33 years.

The artist was featured on the *Windsor Park Stories* Sunday, April 23. This WVIA, Channel 44 show concentrated on the story behind the Millennium Collection.

"In my wildest dreams, I never thought that my work would be the subject of a one hour television show," she said.

Sue Hand's Millennium Collection will go on display at Allied Services John Heinz Institute in Wilkes-Barre this week. An opening reception is scheduled for Sunday, April 30 from 2 p.m. to 5 p.m. The artist will give a short gallery presentation at 2:30 p.m. in the dining room.

Towns schedule spring cleanups

Three Back Mountain communities will hold their annual spring cleanup the week of May 8-13. Each town's hours and list of acceptable items varies, so check the complete information below for the details your town.

In addition, Harveys Lake will open its Dumpster April 29.

DALLAS TOWNSHIP

TIMES: Mon.-Fri., 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Saturday, 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

LOCATION: Rear of Dallas Township Municipal Building, Rt. 309. Proof of residency is required at time of drop off. There will be a service charge of \$5 for large items such as: carpets, overstuffed chairs, couches, dressers, stoves, washers, dryers, T.V.'s, refrigerators, water heaters, tanks, freezers, etc.

TIRES: \$2 each, limit two per household.

The following items will not be accepted: Hazardous wastes, chemicals, brush, tree stumps, cinder blocks, animal or human waste, shingles, sheet rock or other building materials, leaves, grass, garbage or newspapers.

KINGSTON TWP.

TIMES: Mon.-Fri. 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Saturday 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

LOCATION: Kingston Township Public Works Facility, E. Center St., Shavertown. Spring cleanup is open to Kingston Township residents only.

LARGE LOADS: Residents with full size vans, pickup trucks, and trucks larger than a regular pickup truck bed will be required to obtain an admission coupon from the Kingston Township Muni-

pal Building, Monday through Friday 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Coupons for full size vans and pickups are free of charge and are limited to one per township residence. Coupons for trucks larger than pickup trucks, such as U-Haul vans, small dump trucks, and stake body trucks, are available for a fee of \$85. Proof of residency such as a tax bill or driver's license is required to receive a coupon. Trailers require a coupon for one trip only. Admission coupons are issued to the occupants of rental units, not the owners.

TIRES: Limit of two per residence.

NOT ACCEPTED: Washers, dryers, furnaces, stoves, refrigerators, water heaters, or other large appliances. Also, household garbage, recyclable materials, commercial construction debris and medical waste will not be accepted. No toxic substances such as paint, solvents, fertilizers, or automotive fluids will be accepted.

Residents with passenger cars or other vehicles not described above must show proof of residency to police officers on duty at the entrance to the cleanup. Police officers will also collect admission coupons.

DALLAS BOROUGH

TIMES: Mon.-Fri. 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Saturday 7 a.m. to 3 p.m.

LOCATION: Any Dallas Borough resident can bring unwanted articles to the collection site located behind the borough garage.

25 Main St. Proof of residency required.

NOT ACCEPTED: Items not acceptable include garbage, yard waste, toxic materials, asbestos, construction debris, paint in cans, sealed containers, batteries and ashes.

HARVEYS LAKE

Harveys Lake Borough announces the dumpster will open Saturday, April 29, from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. Everything will be accepted except chemical or hazardous waste materials. Paint cans will be allowed as long as there is no paint left in the cans. It is also requested residents bundle or bag small, loose items.

The dumpster will be open on the following dates throughout 2000: April 29; June 24; July 29; Aug. 26; Sept. 30; and Oct. 28 from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. After October 28, the dumpster will be closed for the year until next spring when it will reopen in April, weather permitting.

This year in order to try and deter people from outside the Lake dumping at our garage, a permit will be required. It will only be necessary to purchase one permit and that permit will be good until October of this year. These permits may be purchased at the Borough Office on Rt. 415, Sunset.

The permit will cost \$10 for the entire season. Any major "white" appliances will cost an additional \$5. Identification of residency or home ownership will be required to obtain a permit. Anyone having questions may call the Borough office at 639-2113 from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Grange Bank will take over Pioneer branch

Management of Grange National Bank and Grange National Bank Corp. (GRGN) have announced plans to acquire the Pioneer American Bank branch office at Mr. Z's supermarket in Tunkhannock.

Grange will acquire the facility and deposits and will assume the lease obligations of Pioneer American Bank. Other terms were not

disclosed. The transaction is subject to regulatory approval and is expected to be consummated in mid-June. Both banks plan no interruption of service for the branch's customers.

The Grange National Bank currently operates 10 full service branch offices in Wyoming, Susquehanna, Bradford and Luzerne counties, including Trucksville.

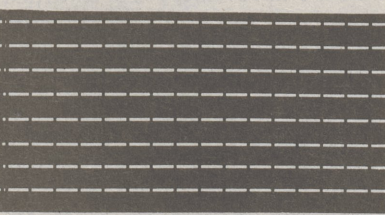

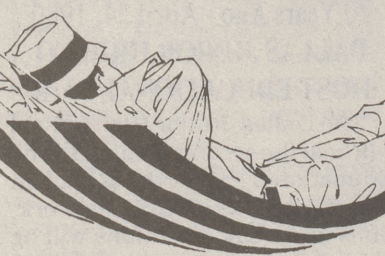
