Back Mountain Trail receives \$5,000 grant

The Back Mountain Trail received \$5,000 from Representative George Hasay to use for the construction of the Trucksville Trailhead. It is located next to Trucksville Pharmacy on Carverton Road. DCED (Department of Community Economic Development) funds are being specifically used for this purpose.

The Back Mountain Trail extension from Post Road to Carverton was made possible by an easement agreement between Anthracite Scenic Trails Association (ASTA) and Kingston Township.

Recently, Jay Elston, contractor, opened the Trail. The Trailhead is open for use, but will not be completed until summer of 2001. A design must be submitted by ASTA, approved by the Kingston Township Supervisors, and accepted by the Trucksville Pharmacy first.

The Back Mountain Trail is presently submitting a grant application to DCNR (Department of Conservation and Natural Resources) to contract for engineering services for twelve more miles of Trail development.

A public meeting will be held at the Kingston Township Building on Nov. 2, at 7 p.m. on East Center St. in Shavertown to discuss this extension from Kirby Park to Luzerne Borough and Trucksville to Harveys Lake through Shavertown, Dallas Borough and Dallas Township. ASTA has already received \$480,000 from PennDOT and the Federal Highway agency under Transportation Enhancement Act 21 for construction costs.

Interfaith Council to honor Sisters of Mercy

The Interfaith Council of Wyoming Valley will honor the Sisters of Mercy of the Dallas Regional Community at their Annual Community Interfaith Luncheon to be held on Monday, Nov. 20 at Genetti's Best Western Hotel in Wilkes-Barre. The Citation of Distinction will be conferred upon the Sisters of Mercy as they celebrate 125 years of service in the Wyoming Valley.

The Interfaith Council was established in 1977 by leaders of the Protestant, Catholic and Jewish faiths to provide a structure that enhances and strengthens interfaith relations in the Wyoming Valley by exploring and addressing the social structures of the civic community and the social problems within the region. The Sisters of Mercy were chosen to be

honored at this year's luncheon in light of their leadership role in addressing social problems and commitment to enhancing the life of the community

The focus of the citation will be on those activities which specifically demonstrate the ideals of human dignity, compassion and friendship for all people regardless of religious affiliation. Four of the Sisters' sponsored ministries will be highlighted. In 1973, Sr. Susanne Stutz, RSM began Project Remain, an outreach program for senior citizens in six high-rise apartment buildings in order to address the needs of senior adults. The Catherine McAuley Center, which offers housing to homeless women and children, was begun by Sr. Anne Paye, RSM in 1984. In 1988, Sr. Miriam Francis Stadulis,

RSM developed the McGlynn Learning Center, an outreach program in the Boulevard Town Housing Complex which provides educational, recreational, social and health programs to families. Sr. Lucille Brislin, RSM began a cooperative venture in 1993 with the Commission on Economic Opportunity and St. John's Lutheran Church in 1993. Mercy Services provides a neighborhood-based educational and enrichment program for children from low income families.

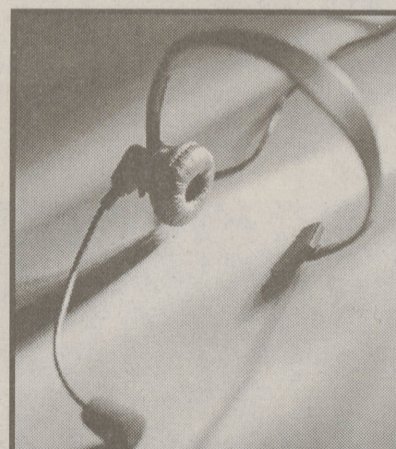

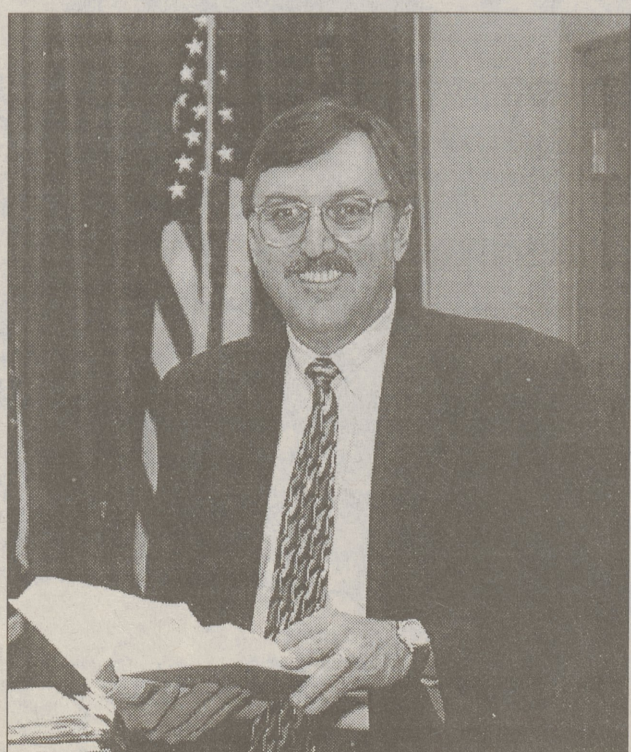
