Savatteri graduates from Widner

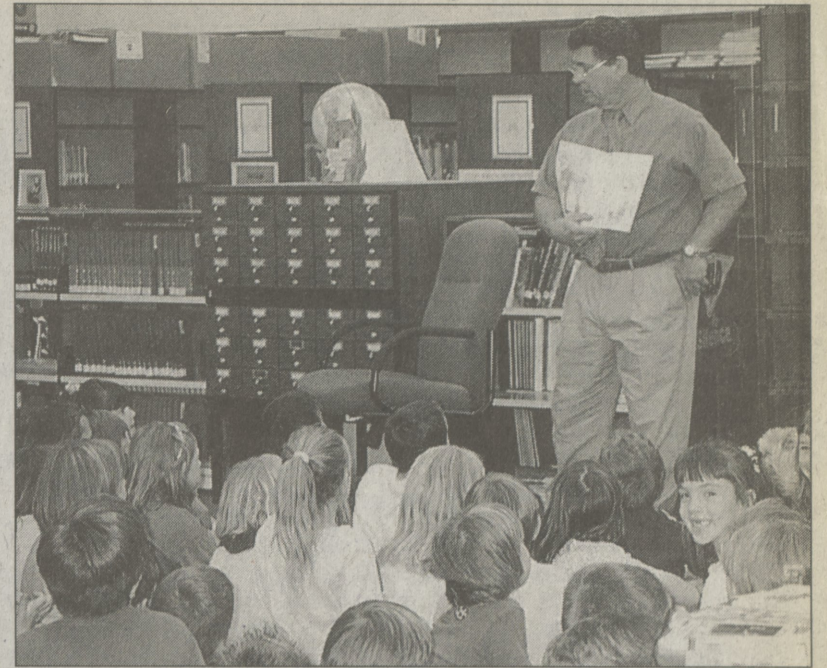
Salvatore Savatteri, Trucksville, earned a juris doctor degree from the Harrisburg campus of Widner University.
