All bills were mailed to the property owner and/or resident at their last known address. Anyone who does not receive their bill should notify the tax collector immediately. Anyone with an escrow account should forward only the property tax bill on to their mortgage company for payment. Per capita tax bills are to be paid by the residents. Single residents whose income does not exceed \$5,000 and married couples whose income does not exceed \$10,000 are eligible to apply to the school district for exoneration from the per capita tax. Forms can be obtained at the school district or the tax collectors office upon request. Tax payments must be postmarked on or before Sep. 7 to be eligible for the 2% rebate value. 
