

Green Rd. closed for construction Lehman Twp. tax notice

Kingston Township has announced the work has begun on the street improvement project on Green Rd. The contractor on the Project, Lagana Construction Services, will be closing the road for construction starting Tues., July 31, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. The road will be open for local traffic only. Residents will be al-

lowed access. The construction will continue for approximately six weeks with frequent road closings.

The Township and the contractor ask residents and the general public to use alternate routes. If there are any questions please call Township manager Jeffrey Box at 696-3809.

Lehman Township Tax Collector, Peggy Moyer, reminds residents that the 2001 Lake-Lehman School District property and per capita taxes were mailed Mon., July 9. All bills were mailed to the property owner and/or resident at their last known address.

Anyone who does not receive their bill should notify the tax collector immediately. Anyone with an escrow account should forward only the property tax bill on to their mortgage company for payment. Per capita tax bills are to be paid by the residents.

Single residents whose income does not exceed \$5,000 and married couples whose income does not exceed \$10,000 are eligible to apply to the school district for exoneration from the per capita tax. Forms can be obtained at the school district or the tax collectors office upon request.

Tax payments must be post-marked on or before Sept. 7 to be eligible for the 2% rebate value. To receive a receipt, enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope with your payment.

Standing water unlawful

The Kingston Township Zoning Officer reminds the residents of the township that is unlawful to have any collection of standing water, except for agricultural purposes, in which mosquitoes are likely to breed, unless such collection of water is treated or maintained to prevent such breeding.

The Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection and Health warns there is a chance the West Nile Virus could be spread into Pennsylvania this summer by the common mosquito. Township resi-

dents are requested to eliminate from their property any accumulation of stagnant water to help prevent the spread of mosquitoes.

Lake Twp. 911 system

Lake Township residents should be aware that the 911 System is wrapping up the survey for assigning street addresses. They will be calling each telephone number to check the accuracy of their list. They are asking for the residents cooperation to make this possible. However, it will be several months before residents will be notified of their new address. The list must be submitted to the United

States Postal Service for approval, and then the mailings must be prepared and sent out.

Proper posting of signs

The Kingston Township Zoning Officer reminds the residents of the township it is illegal to attach garage/yard sale signs to utility/telephone poles or trees. The signs should be attached to individual stakes. All such signs should be removed no later than two days after the sale. Violators may be fined up to \$300. NUI provides water service to Luzerne County: Midway Manor, Kingston Twp.; Oak Hill, Lehman Twp.; Rhodes Terrace, Lehman Twp.; and Warden Place, Lake Twp.
