• Fuel funds available for vol. fire cos.

Volunteer fire company officials are urged to take advantage of a state program which reimburses state gas tax paid on liquid fuel purchases for company vehicles. Completed claim forms must be post marked or received no later than Sept. 30.

The refund rates, for gasoline purchased on or after Jan. 1 are 26 cents per gallon for gasoline and 30.9 cents per gallon for kerosene and diesel fuel.


Each claim must include copies of paid receipts or a statement from the fuel dealer showing the number of gallons purchased, purchase dates and verification the state taxes were paid.

To qualify, applicants must be commercial or nonprofit farmers in Connecticut, Delaware, Maine, Massachusetts, Maryland, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, West Virginia, Vermont, or Washington, D.C.
