Misericordia Choral Society seeks new members

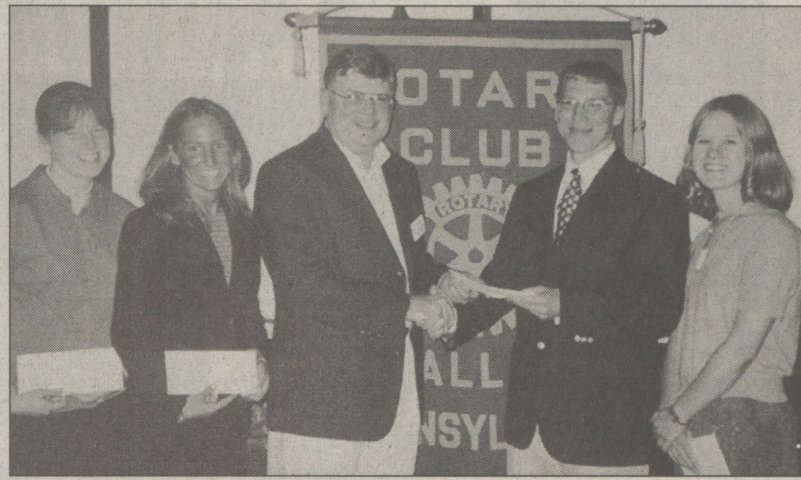
