Chicken barbecue Oct. 5-6

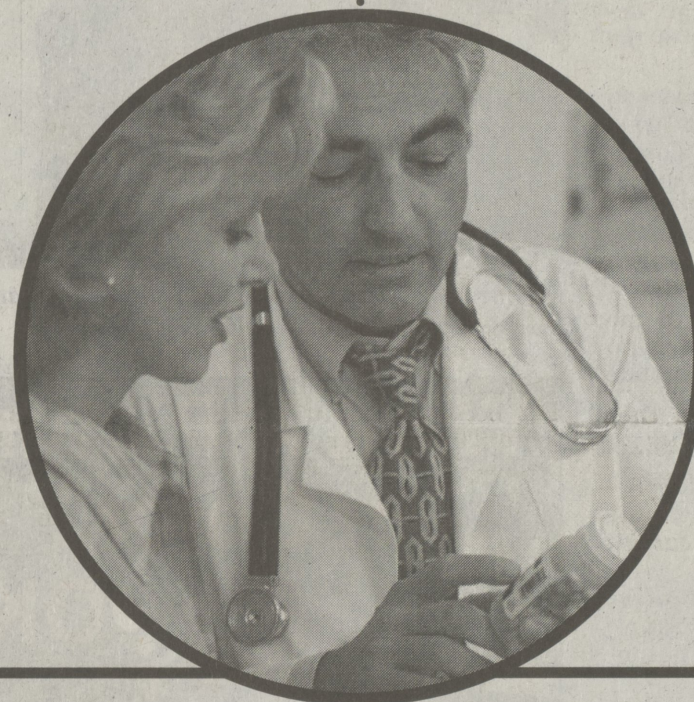
