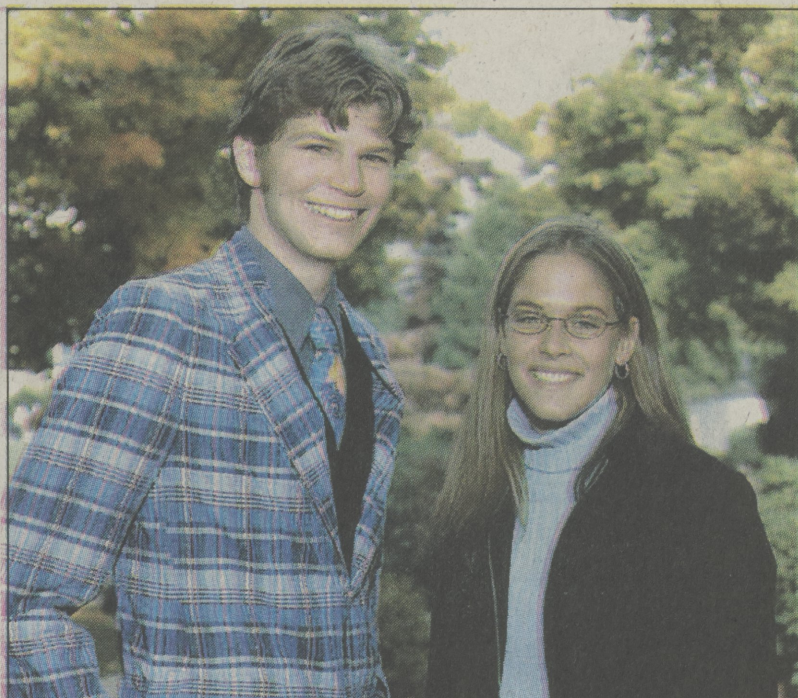
20 Years Ago - November 11, 1981
