# **New video at Dallas Library** offers solutions to sprawl

Back Mountain Memorial Library has a new video. Saving Pennsylvania, that shows how Pennsylvanians can save their cities, towns, and countryside.

The hour-long documentary was given to the library - and every other public library in the state - by the Wyomissing Foundation as part of an effort to reform Pennsylvania's land use policies

"During the past 50 years, nearly all Pennsylvania cities have lost population and vitality, even as we've consumed millions of acres of farmland and open space for sprawling development," said David Thun, vice president of the Wyomissing Foundation. "Saving Pennsylvania shows that it doesn't have to be this way. We can revitalize our cities and preserve our countryside at the same time." Saving Pennsylvania originally

aired on all Pennsylvania public monwealth.


