How are you doing? I am doing just fine. I have a little list for your first I want a white and happy Christmas so my family can seat

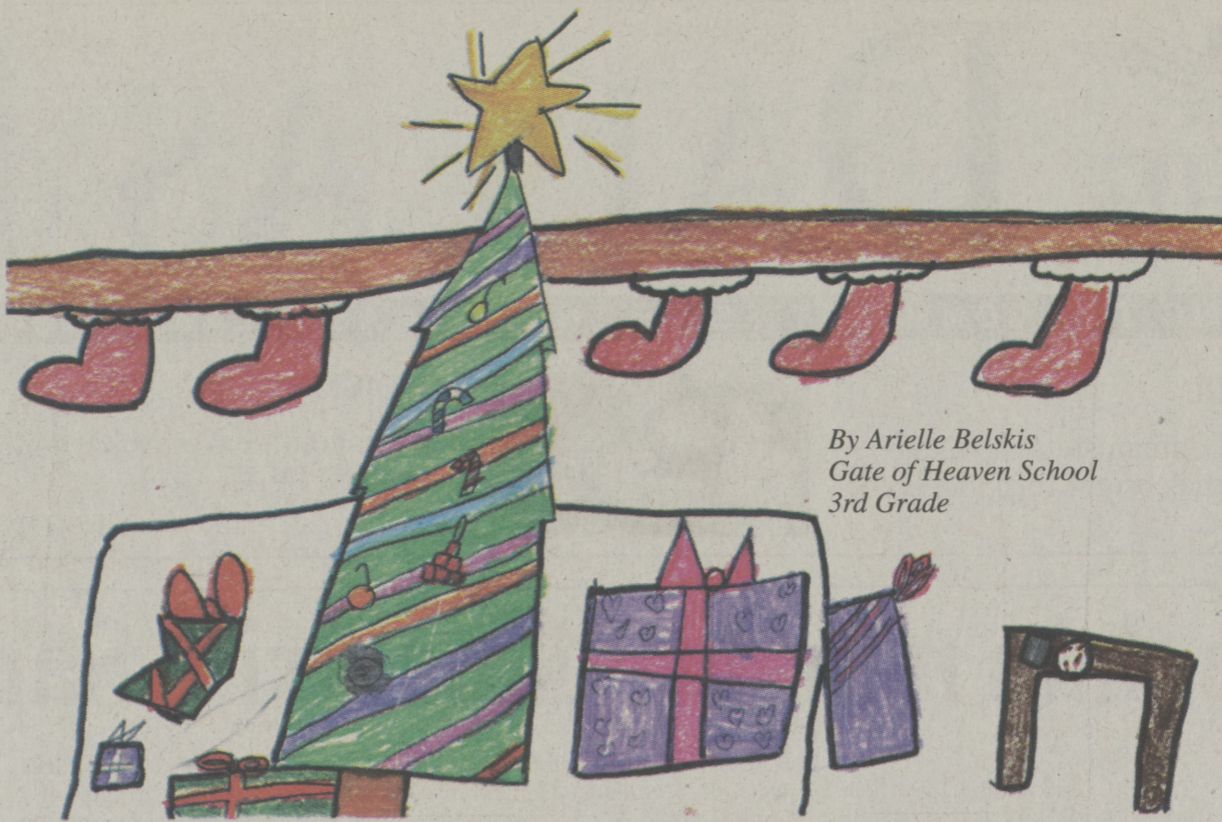
Dear Santa,

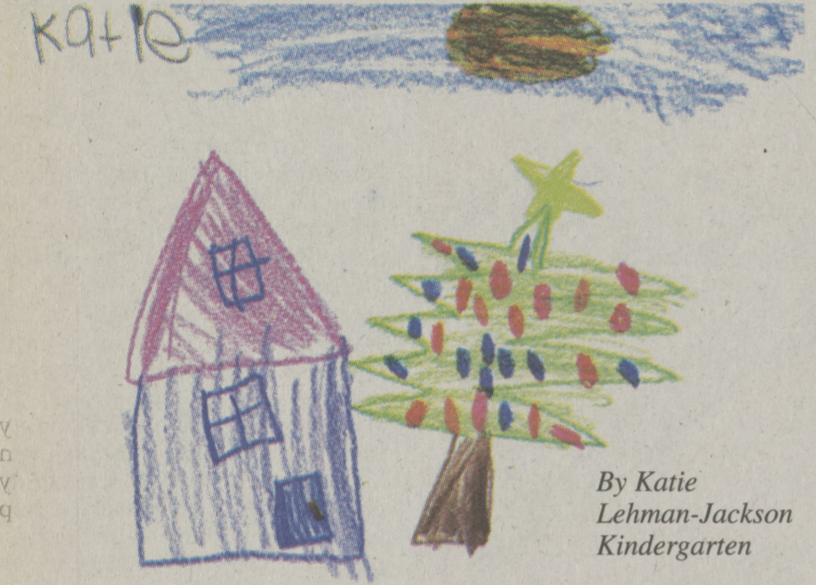
