College Misericordia administration building undergoing renovations

College Misericordia has begun an extensive renovation of its 78-year old administration building.

Improvements will include renovations in many areas of the building including the ground, first and second floors. Work is expected to take approximately 10 months.

"We believe these improvements will provide much needed classroom space to accommodate our growing enrollment and new academic programs," says Dr. Michael MacDowell, president.

The ground floor will house classrooms as well as elements of the College's finance division, including information technology and the controller's office. The first floor will consolidate several student services in one area, including the registrar, student accounts and financial aid.

New classrooms and offices for speech-language pathology, CM's newest five-year entry level master's degree, will be built on the second floor, occupying some of the former library space. The College's Diversity Institute will temporarily move to the second floor along with the institutional

advancement division. Also planned is a "Founders Room" that pays tribute to Sisters of Mercy who pioneered the College.

Funding for the \$2.7 million project is provided by College Misericordia's ongoing Advancing the Vision fundraising campaign. The campaign is also supporting the development of 19 acres of land west of campus to accommodate a new lacrosse and track and field facility. This highly successful campaign currently stands at \$3,700,000, including a \$300,000 grant from the Kresc Foundation. An additional \$600,000 is needed to bring the campaign to a successful conclusion.

Earlier this year, cosmetic improvements to the exterior of the administration building included both window painting and masonry work. Also renovated during summer were the highly visible entrance arch and McHale Hall.

Parking on campus was also increased by 80 spaces with the demolition of the aging tennis courts and realignment of existing parking spaces.
