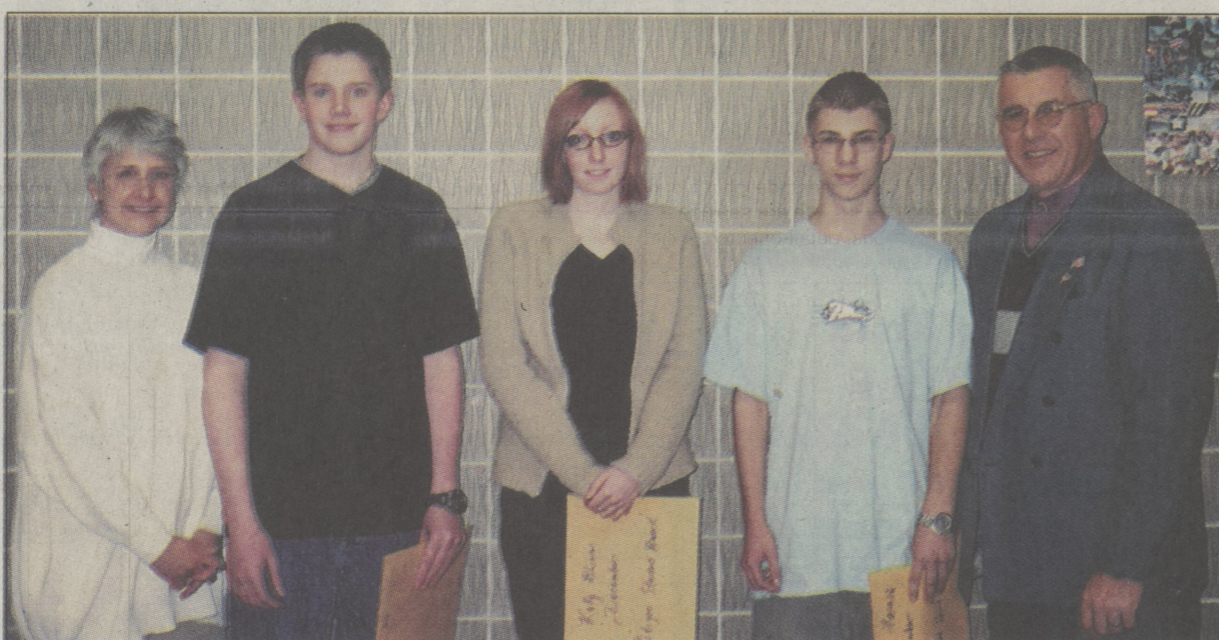
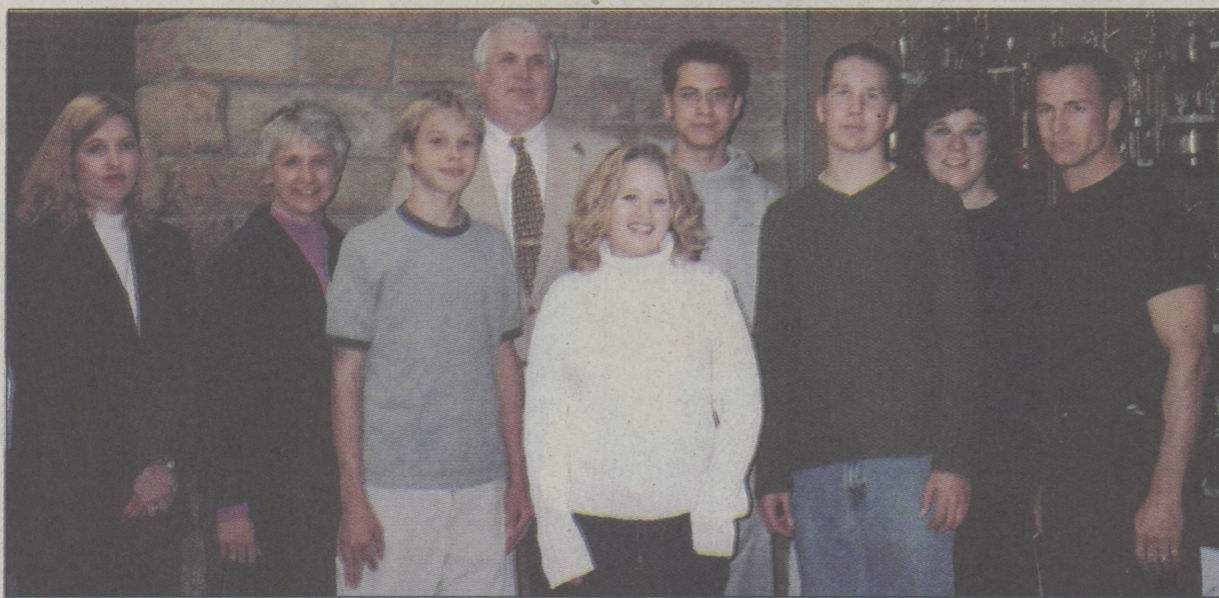

Lake-Lehman sets kindergarten registration

Robert Kunkle and Dave McLaughlin-Smith, Elementary Principals for the Lake-Lehman School District, announced recently Kindergarten Registration and screening for eligible kindergarten students on March 4, 5 and 6. Lake-Lehman School District policy states a child must be 5 years of age on or before September 1, 2002 in order to register for kindergarten for the 2002-2003 school year. Kindergarten in the Lake-Lehman School District is an all-day program.

Parents are asked to bring all necessary immunization records to school at the time of registration. No child will be admitted in the Lake-Lehman School District until proof of immunization is presented to the school nurse. Parents are required to furnish proof of the child's age before entrance to kindergarten. Please bring the child's birth certificate along with his/her social security number. The child must be in attendance.

Dallas to hold kindergarten registration for 2002-03 yr.

Dr. Gilbert R. Griffiths, Superintendent of the Dallas School District, announces Kindergarten Registration for the 2002-03 school year will be held from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. and 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. on March 18, 19, 20, and 21 in the gymnasium of the Gerald J. Wycallis Elementary School on Conyngham Ave., Dallas. A Birth Certificate or other acceptable evidence of age and the Social Security Card must accompany each registration. A child must be five years of age on or before September 1, 2002 to make him/her eligible for kindergarten.

Those with last names beginning with A, B, C, D, E and F

will register on Monday, March 18 those with G, H, I, J, K and L on Tuesday, March 19 those with M, N, O, P, Q and R on Wednesday, March 20 and those with S, T, U, V, W, X, Y and Z on Thursday, March 21. Children who enter First Grade, but did not attend the Dallas Kindergarten program this past term, may register on Thursday, March 21.

In addition to the registration, vision and speech screenings will be given. Kindergarten teachers will be available to answer any questions or concerns. Parents must bring all records of their child's immunizations.
