If you are the owner of a home or property in Kingston Township and did not receive a tax bill, it is your responsibility to notify the tax collector at 696-3809. If you are a new owner of an established home and did not receive a tax bill, notify the tax collector so records can be changed accordingly. All payments must be post-marked on or before April 16, to be eligible for the rebate.

Regular office hours at the municipal building, 180 E. Center St., Shavertown, are Monday and Thursday, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. A voice mail message can be left at

696-3809 at anytime and will be answered promptly.
