Carey then lost by fall in the fourth-round consolation to Kennard Dale's Chris Pomraning. In the fifth-place final, Central Cambria's Nate Morris decisioned Carey 4-1.

"I think I could've done better, but I'm happy with what I did," said Carey, the Northeast Region champ who closed the season 41-7. "I made the semis and that's an accomplishment in itself. I took home a medal. That's all I could've asked for."

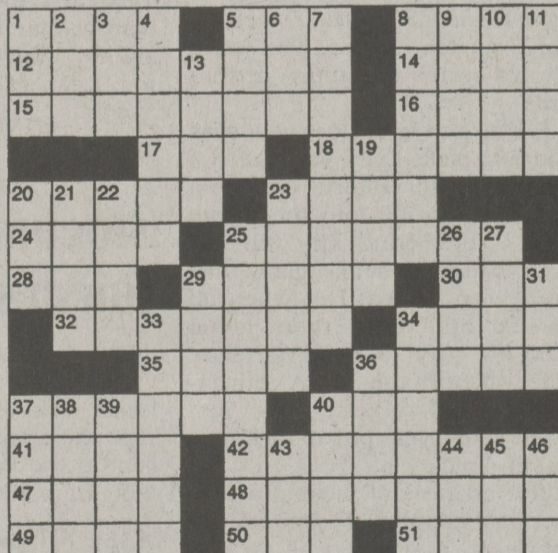
