Shakespeare at Misericordia

For the first time in recent memory, the Misericordia Players, along with faculty and staff, will be performing William Shakespeare's "A Midsummer Night's Dream." The play will be held in College Misericordia's Walsh Auditorium at 8 p.m. on Friday, April 12 and Saturday, April 13. There will also be a 2 p.m. matinee on Sunday, April 14.
