Wilkes University junior Samuel Saylor was recently inducted into the Beta Beta Beta Biological Honor Society. Beta Beta Beta is a society for students, particularly undergraduates, dedicated to improving the understanding and appreciation of biological study and extending boundaries of human knowledge through scientific research.

Since its founding in 1922, more than 175,000 persons have been accepted into lifetime membership, and more than 430 chapters have been established throughout the United States and Puerto Rico. The Theta Delta chapter was installed at Wilkes last year to honor and reward the academic achievements of biology majors. It is the only Tri-Beta chapter in northeast Pennsylvania.

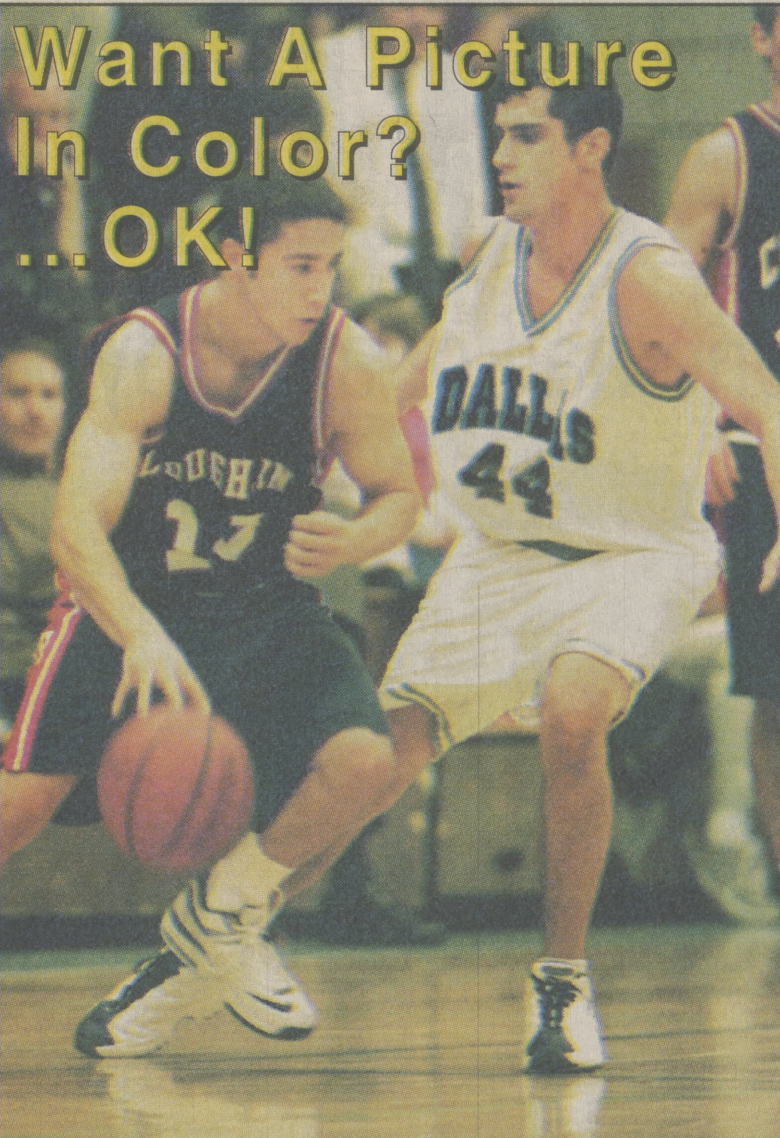
## Sem Mock Trial team 6th in state

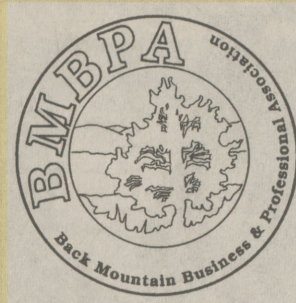
