One of the many highlights will be a high point five show series award for the highest scoring Tandem/Pairs Hunter Division entry at the Dallas Horse and Pony (May 12), Borrowdale Acres (June 2), Back Mountain (Aug. 25), and Showin' Blue (Sept. 22). This award will be presented at the September 22 show. All of these shows will be at the Luzerne County Fair Grounds. There will also be a high point three show series Dressage Award.

The Dallas Horse and Pony Show is a Northeastern PA Horesmen's Association (NPHA) sanctioned event but is open to non-members. Spectator admission is free. The show manager is Jane Morris of Dallas.
