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now obviously less than what it was before he gave away his development rights. In Pennsylvania, at present, that reduction has no effect on the property tax which the landowner pays. However, the value of a conservation easement (the amount is calculated by comparing two appraisals of the land — with and without the easement) is a tax-deductible charitable gift which the landowner can use to reduce federal income taxes.

While the tax-deduction benefit of the easement's value was important to Doug, that was only a sec-

ondary consideration; some landowners choose not to take it at all. They want only the assurance that their special piece of the earth will remain forever unspoiled by human activity.
