Walker Award. Arcangeli was honored recently at the Wilkes-Barre campus Student Government Association Leadership/Athletic Awards Dinner where she was presented with a medallion and a plaque.

The Walker Award recognizes a student from each of the campuses in the Penn State Commonwealth College whose outstanding qualities of character, scholarship, leadership, and citizenship has positively influenced fellow students and has contributed to the prestige and well-being of the campus and to the reputation of the University as a whole.

Arcangeli represented Penn State Wilkes-Barre at Intercollegiate Leadership activities and was voted outstanding club member for her role in the Honor Society. 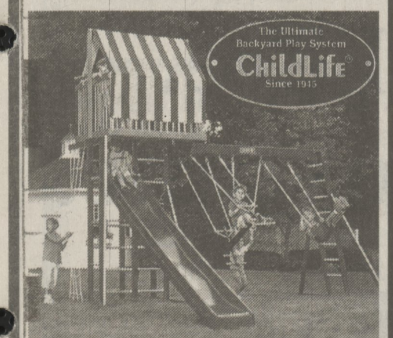
Recognized students receive full room and board for their senior year.
