## Harveys Lake to test drinking water

Harveys Lake EAC and Wilkes University will be offering drinking water testing to harveys Lake Borough residents from 9 a.m.-12 noon on Saturday, June 15. There will be two packages available. The \$30 test (\$75 value) measures water for pH, conductivity, turbidity, total coliform, nitrate, nitrite and phosphate. The \$65 package (\$195 value) measures water for all those plus fecal streptococcus, fecal coliform, alkalinity, hardness, total iron, total manganese, copper, sodium, cor-

sivity calculation and potassium. A \$5 deposit is required when picking up your sampling packet. Full payment is due when you drop the sample off on June 15.

Sample containers and instructions can be picked up at the Municipal Building before June 15. Call the Borough Office at 639-2113 if you have any questions. Final testing results will be confidentially mailed to participants from Wilkes Laboratory within 1-2 weeks of the testing.
