Kingston Township Summer Rec Program registration

The 2002 Kingston Township Summer Recreation Program will be held from June 17 through August 9. The program is open to resident children of Kingston Township who have completed kindergarten up to and including the completion of sixth grade, but no children older than 12. Proof of residency, such as a tax bill or drivers license will be required at the time of registration. A \$20 registration fee will be collected at registration for the first child in a family, a \$10 fee for each additional child thereafter. Parents are reminded that the children are responsible for their own admission fees for field trips, swimming and other activities.

This Summer Program will be conducted each weekday, weather permitting, from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Program participants will meet at the Center Street Park each morning. Children should bring a bag lunch and drink each day.
