said. "Number one, it's not fair to the kids who have to start practice in September. We are going to have to rent a pool

"I don't know about anybody else, but I have a big problem that month after month, it keeps getting delayed, and keeps getting delayed and keeps getting delayed, and we keep approving payments for these guys."

Gallo told the board there was no way to anticipate that the problem with the pool would arise, and that the responsibility lay with the the pool contractor and electrical contractor G.R. Noto, who set the project back nearly two months because of a three week delay getting supplies on site. He said manpower has not been an issue in the pool.

Dallas superintendent Dr. Gil Griffiths told Gallo and the board the school had already hired a pool manager, instructors, two maintenance personnel, lifeguards and lifeguard aides for the school year, and would now have to rent pool time from College Misericordia so the third grade curriculum would not be set back.

"We have that time and manpower commitment just sitting out there," said Griffiths.

"We've got a problem and you've got a problem."

Griffiths also said seventh and ninth grade students would be forced to complete a dry land water safety program until the pool was finished.

Board president Ernest Ashbridge told Gallo he wanted the representatives from Revnolds Construction who bid on the project at the board's August 12

"I want those people here at next week's meeting to tell us why we are so far behind," said Ashbridge to Gallo, who responded by saying, "I'll try."

"Don't try. Have it done," Ashbridge shot back. "We've got a problem and you've got a prob-

"The kids went through a lousy year last year, and we thought a large portion of it was going to be done," said school board member Maureen Ma-"Going through (the tiska. school), I don't know much about construction, but I know a mess when I see one.'

When Gallo tried to defend the "mess," saying the corridor project was part of a change order added on later in the project, Ashbridge quickly responded by listing other problems the board found in their walk

through of the school last week. Besides the natatorium, work is still unfinished in the auditorium, in the corridors and in at least one computer lab.

"We're paying for you people to do the managing, and it's not being done,"said Ashbridge. "I am going to recommend that we pay no more management fees for this project until you get on schedule and get all of these items corrected."

In other business:

· Bids for the school district's signage project must be opened to the public, and approval must be granted by Dallas Township before a new sign may be erected, said Paul Degillio of Foreman Burkavage, the project engineer and architect.

 The district will solicit bids for dry wall and storefront work at Dallas Elementary. Degillio told the board the projects would be split up into two separate projects, and prevailing wages would not need to be paid since the total costs of each project won't exceed \$25,000.
