



## College Misericordia receives Newcombe grant

College Misericordia recently received a \$15,000 grant from combe Foundation's continued The Charlotte W. Newcombe Foundation to assist mature women students with their academic studies.

Recently distributed grants for the 2002-2003 academic year ranged from \$15,000 to \$40,000, and total \$587,000. Partial tuition and special expense scholarships may be funded from these awards.
