'The Crucible' at Misericordia

On November 15 and 16 at 8 p.m. and November 17 at 2 p.m. the Misericordia Players will present Arthur Miller's American classic, "The Crucible."

"The Crucible" is set in the late 1600s in Puritan New England during the Salem witch trials. Although the plot of the play focuses around the moral dilemma of the accusations of witchcraft, the real motivation for the play was the trauma

prompted by the McCarthy House Un-American Activities trials of the 1950s.

The theme of intolerance applies equally to the Puritans and McCarthyism, and perhaps to today's society, since we continue to reflect the same paranoia, narrow-mindedness, and disregard for the rights of individuals to which Miller was so passionately opposed. It is still too easy to condemn that which is different or which we do not

understand.

Tickets are \$5 for general admission, \$2 for students and senior citizens and will be available at the door.
