

Misericordia plans sonography program

College Misericordia will start an 18-month certificate program in Diagnostic Medical Sonography (DMS), also known as ultrasound. The certificate program is designed for adult or non-traditional learners who possess the necessary pre-requisites along with an allied health credential such as a registered nurse, emergency medical technician, licensed practical nurse, or radiologic technologist. The program will offer convenient and predictable scheduling with alternating weekend classes and a weekday clinical component.

To help fund the program, the College has received an Allied Health Projects grant in the amount of \$199,621 with \$211,188 contingent on available government funding in 2003 and 2004. The family of the late Dr. Thomas E. Baker has established a sonography fund to help finance the program as well.

Beginning in September 2003 shortage of educated medical professionals in the sonography field. Sonographers perform work in various medical settings including hospitals, outpatient clinics and physician offices.

College Misericordia's Medical Imaging program is accredited by the Joint Review Committee on Education in Radiologic Technology (JRCERT), as well as by the Pennsylvania Department of Education. This instruction provides students with knowledge and practical skills necessary to assume positions in diagnostic radiology or pursue employment or certification in advanced imaging modalities.
