'Flapjack' does double duty this weekend

The Canadian band "Flapjack" will play for a Chicory House New England Contra Dance, Saturday March 1, at 8 p.m. The dance is held at the St. Therese's Church, Pioneer Avenue at Davis street in Shavertown. No partner or previous experience is necessary, and all dances are taught and called.

The night before, the band will take the stage at the Chicory House in Wilkes-Barre at 8 p.m. Doors open at 7:30 in the Community Room of St. Stephen's Church, 35 South Franklin St., just across from Boscov's parking lot.

Contra dancing is a multi-generational community dance that is aerobic, fun, and sociable. Lightweight clothing is recommended.

Flapjack offers a unique Canadian dance repertoire from the Ottawa Valley, Newfoundland, Manitoba and Quebec, arranged for contra and squares. Their music is equally enjoyed by experienced and beginner dancers. Flapjack's style is driving and rhythmic. Flapjack has a contra sound that is refreshingly out of the mold, yet connected to tradition.

Newcomers are warmly welcomed, and are asked to join in the very first dance of the evening with an experienced partner (if possible). Getting started by letting other dancers guide you is much more effective than watching. Newcomers will discover that the more experienced dancers will dance at the level of their partner, adjusting their dancing to match the skill level and style of whoever they may be dancing with at the moment.

Caller Katy Heine will teach

each dance and have couples perform a short routine with another couple before progressing onto the next couple and repeating the sequence. A different routine is taught before each dance.

The Chicory House is an all-volunteer non-profit coffeehouse, sponsoring folk music and dance in the Wyoming Valley. Admission is \$6 for adults and \$15 for families. 
