North Pocono 2, Dallas 0

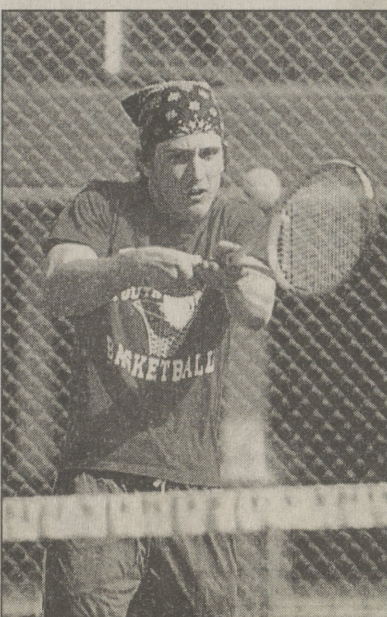
MOSCOW — North Pocono easily took the first game 15-6, but Dallas battled back in the second before falling 15-13.

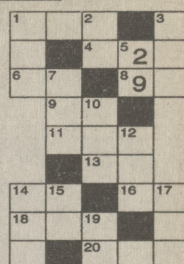
