## Terrorism expert will speak at Penn State Wilkes-Barre

"Terrorism and YOU, Attacks on Democracy in the 21st Century," will be presented by Martin Slann, Ph.D., director of academic affairs at Penn State Wilkes-Barre, in the campus Center for Technology 101 on Tuesday, April 22 from 6-7:30 p.m. Dr. Slann's lecture will focus on the terrorist's motivations, increased lethality, and terrorism as a global menace.

An expert on terrorism, Dr.

Slann has authored and co-authored numerous articles and books on the subject. Among his publications are the Encyclopedia of Terrorism (with Cindy Combs); Multi-Dimensional Terrorism, Violence and Terrorism, and Ideological and Political Dimensions of International Terrorism (all with Bernard Schechterman).

His textbook supplement, The September 11 Attack on America

and Its Aftermath will appear in the introductory section of all upcoming American Government and Political textbooks published by Houghton Mifflin.
