Historical Association to discuss Back Mountain architecture

The architecture of distinctive homes located in the Back Mountain will be the topic of discussion for the next Back Mountain Historical Association meeting, scheduled for Wednesday, April 23. The meeting will be held at 7 p.m. at the Catherine McGowan Conference Center in the Mary Kintz Bevevino Library on the College Misericordia campus in Dallas.

Noted architect Carl J. Handman, A.I.A., of the architectural firm of Eyerma, Csala,

Hapeman and Handman, will give an informal presentation on significant homes of the Back Mountain designed by architects in the years between World War I and World War II. Many familiar homes in beautiful settings of the Back Mountain were designed by regionally and nationally acclaimed architects. Handman will display photographs of these homes and discuss their design and history.

Also during the meeting, Dr. Allan Austin, assistant profes-

sor of history at College Misericordia, will join his students in a presentation of the BMHA's oral history project. The new digital Back Mountain Archives, compiled by Dawn Pangrazzi, College Misericordia archivist and local resident Clyde Davis will be premiered.
