Rich Eckman won the 400, Jamie Moyer won the 300 hurdles and Preston Smith led a Lehman sweep in the high jump.

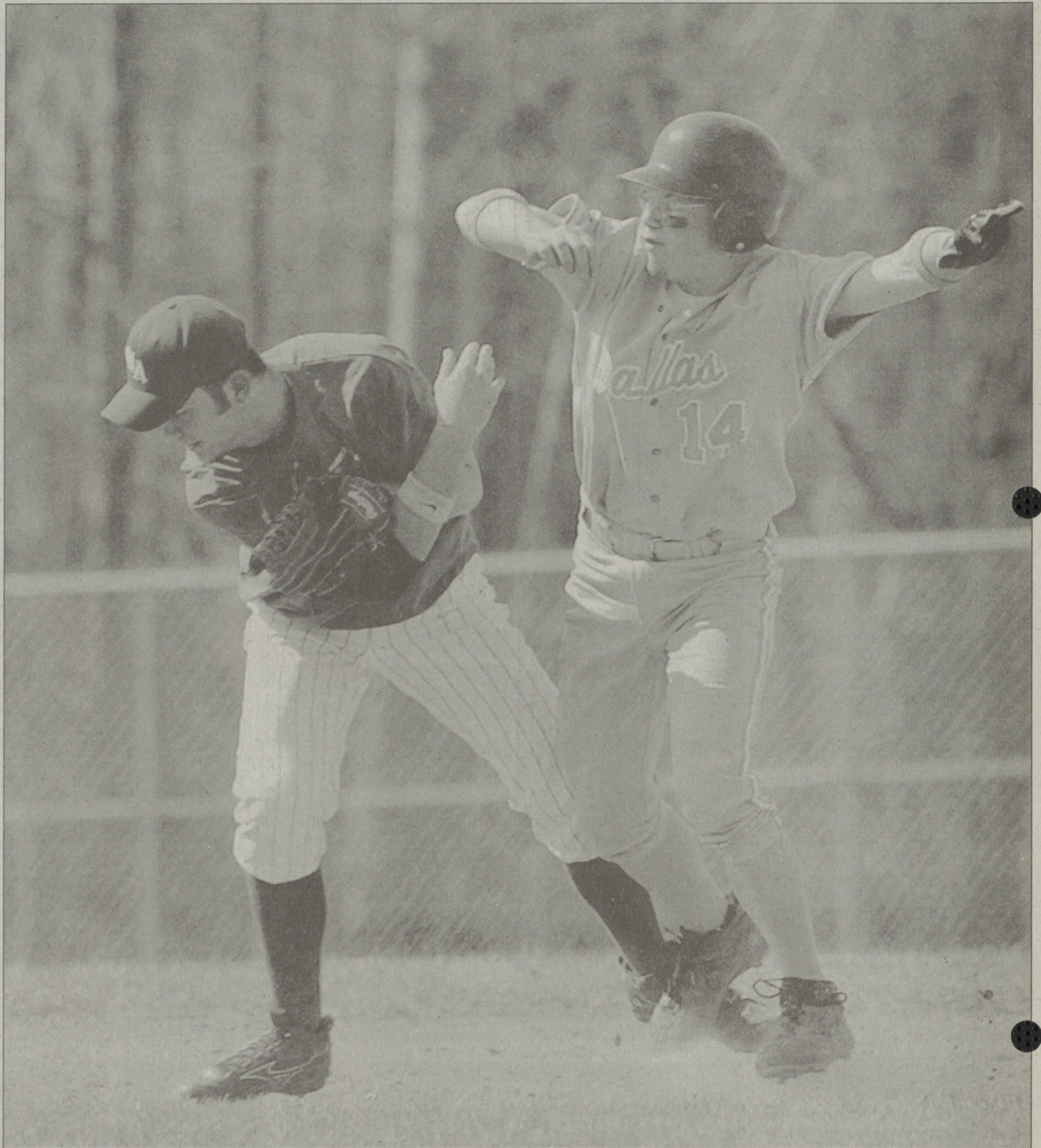
Dallas 102, GAR 40
