He and his wife, Deborah endowed a scholarship for undergraduate IST students at Penn State Wilkes-Barre. The first class of IST baccalaureate degree graduates will receive their diplomas at this ceremony.

Reese is also a recipient of the prestigious Penn State Alumni Fellow Award, a lifetime award given to honor prominent and outstanding alumni who are leaders in their fields and have contributed to society and their community.
